

Jeb White Appears on NPR Affiliate Radio Show

As a trusted authority of the law, Mr. White has penned amicus curiae briefs in four United States Supreme Court cases, examining the federal False Claims Act, and he has lectured over one hundred times on the subjects of False Claims Act litigation and health care fraud schemes. Mr. White is the former President and current Board member of Taxpayers Against Fraud (TAF), a nonprofit public interest organization dedicated to combating fraud against the federal government.
